

Ag Advisory Committee Minutes for December 7, 2009

Meeting commenced at 7:40 pm with Chester Urbanski, Bill Kiriluk, Greg Sappington and Dave Miller in attendance. Dave Hauser absent.

The committee discussed a replacement for David Hauser with several residents mentioned but no one in particular chosen. More choices will be discussed at the next meeting.

Chester discussed the possibility of fertilizer contamination by lawn application companies with Ed Wengren of the NJ Farm Bureau and Mr. Wengren was of the opinion that since the lawn companies were in the business to make money he didn't believe that they would over apply. On the same subject Chester also spoke with an individual from Princeton Hydro about clarifying some items on their report and was told he could set up a meeting with the president of the company who was in charge of the project and they would discuss further action to be taken.

The Township is expected to close on the Toll property on the south side of Route 179 in the spring and the Township wishes to find a company or individuals who may be interested in the trees planted on the property. The Township is willing to give the trees away in return for brush cutting and filling in the tree excavation holes with soil so the fields may be farmed.

Lastly the committee reviewed chapter 109-202 thru 109-250 of the township code with no changes or comment.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm with the next meeting scheduled for January 4th 2010.
