I am pleased to inform you that Township Of West Amwell has been selected to receive funding from the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT) Fiscal Year 2019 Municipal Aid Program for the Mill Road Improvement Project Project in the amount of \$150,000.

NJDOT's Municipal Aid Program is a very competitive program. This year the Department received 681 applications requesting more than \$377.9 million. There is \$161.25 million available in funds from the Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) supported by the State gas tax.

As part of the Department's Commitment to Community, NJDOT provides statewide assistance for local governments for improvements to and preservation of the local transportation network, this network makes up about 90 percent of New Jersey's roadways. Dear Mayor Bergenfeld:

Enclosed is one (1) original executed Agreement approved by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) for the above referenced project in the amount of **\$252,650.00**.

This project will be funded from the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act. State participation in the cost of the project is limited to 100 percent of the cost of the completed construction work including construction inspection and material testing, or the amount of the allotment, whichever is less.

The construction contract must be awarded **within 24 months** from **February 21, 2018** the date of the grant notification letter from Laine Rankin, Director, Division of Local Aid and Economic Development. Failure to make an award by **February 21, 2020**, or failure to comply with the requirements of the Municipal Aid Regulations, N.J.A.C. 16:20B, and the Terms and Conditions of Grant Agreement for State Aid to Counties and Municipalities, will jeopardize the use of State funds on this project. It is further noted that the project must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act requirements for accessibility.
