15TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT BEGINS OFFICE HOURS IN HUNTERDON COUNTY

(TRENTON) – Assemblywoman Elizabeth M. Muoio of the 15th Legislative District (Mercer/Hunterdon) has announced regularly scheduled office hours at the Phillip L. Pittore Justice Center in Lambertville, Hunterdon County. Beginning June 16, staff members from her office, as well as the offices of State Senator Shirley Turner, and Assemblyman Reed Gusciora will be available from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM on the third Tuesday of every month to answer questions, listen to the concerns of residents and provide information regarding state government and services.

Increasing public access to government is nothing new for Asw. Muoio. As chair of the Mercer County Freeholder Board, Muoio re-instituted a long dormant practice of holding meetings on the road. “I believe it is important to raise public awareness and participation in government,” said Muoio, “bringing our services to the community is one way to increase our engagement with constituents.”

In addition to seven towns in Mercer County, the 15th Legislative District is comprised of three municipalities from Hunterdon County: East Amwell, Lambertville and West Amwell. “It is important to ensure that our Hunterdon County residents have access to our office,” said Asm. Gusciora, “in this regard, we are taking our services to them.”

Residents are also welcome to visit the permanent district offices of the legislators. Senator Turner’s office is located at 1230 Parkway Ave., Suite 103, Ewing Township. Assemblyman Gusciora and Assemblywoman Muoio offices are located across the street from the State House at 144 West State Street, Trenton.


