Dear West Amwell Resident,

We are pleased to announce that Raritan Headwaters (RHA) will be offering citizens an opportunity to test their private wells for contaminants.

Test kits will be available for purchase at the [West Amwell Municipal Building](#) on Saturday, May 20, 8:00 am to 12:30 pm.

The basic kit costs \$60 and contains two tests - one for coliform bacteria and one for nitrates, both of which we recommend private wells be tested for annually. If you are concerned that other pollutants might be present in your

drinking water, RHA offers a [full menu of tests](#)--including arsenic, radon, lead, volatile organic compounds, and more--at discounted prices.

Each test kit comes with easy-to-follow instructions and containers for collecting water samples. **Samples will be accepted at the West Amwell Municipal Building between 7:00 am and 10:00 am on Tuesday, May 23.** You should expect to receive your test results in 2-3 weeks. If pollutants are detected, RHA will provide information to help you take corrective action to ensure your water is safe for consumption.

Nationally, nearly half of all people get their water from groundwater sources. Safe drinking water is essential to good health, and **testing well water at a certified lab is the only way to detect pollutants.**
